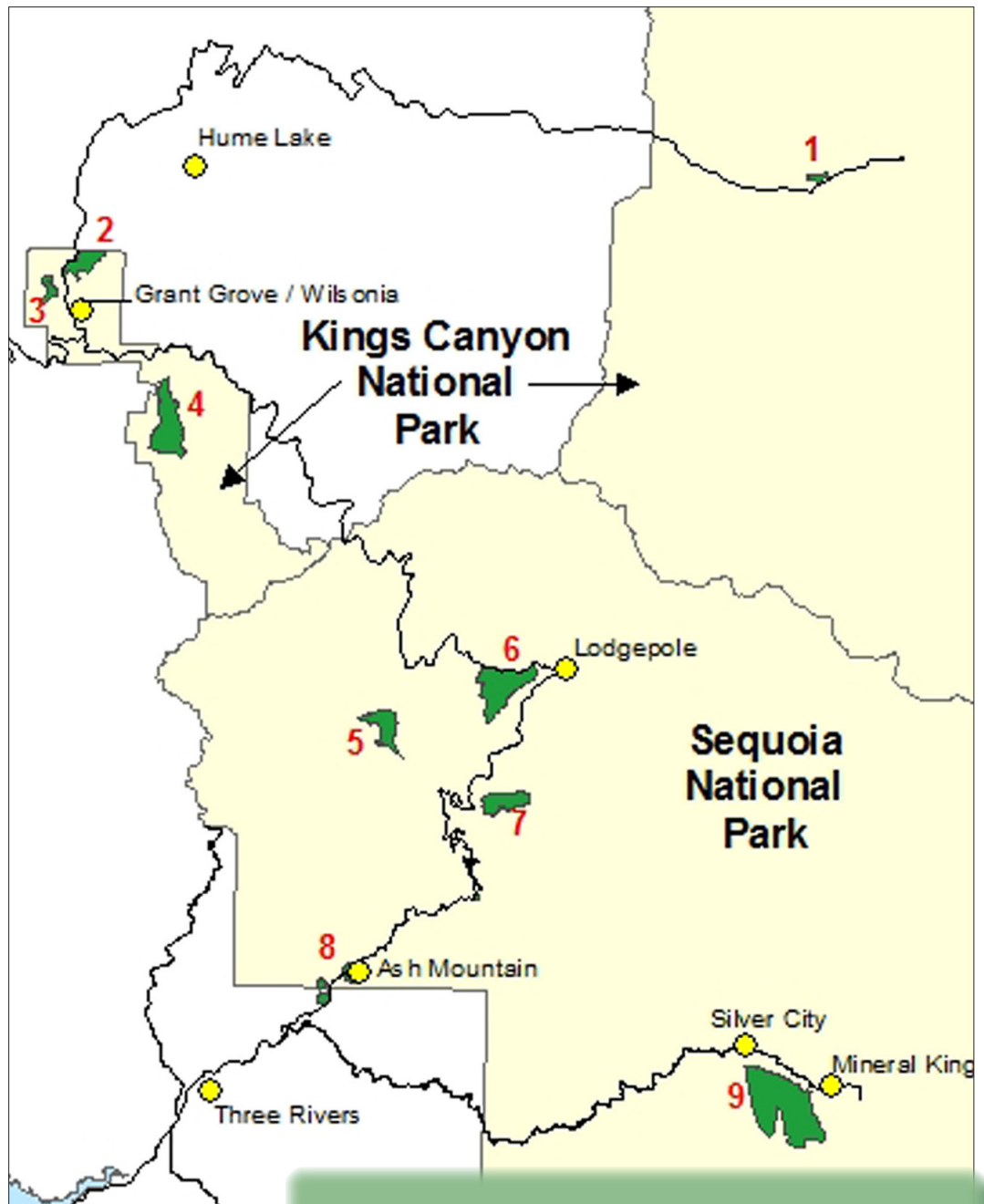


Project Locations for 2011

The parks are planning 9 projects this year totaling up to 3,843 acres. They are designed to improve protection of communities and restore or maintain forest health. Remember, the ultimate timing and completion of burns depends on funding, air quality, local and national fire activity, fuel moistures, and weather.

Lightning fires and human-caused fires are unplanned events. NPS crews are trained to respond to these situations. When necessary, the parks shift priorities from planned projects to respond to other fires.
