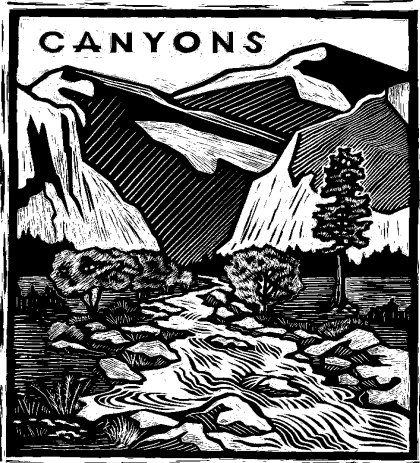

## Program Descriptions

**Zumwalt Meadow Meander:** Explore the variety of environments around the largest meadow in Kings Canyon on a leisurely walk with a ranger. Friday, Saturday and Sunday 2:00 pm.

**Campfire Program: Life Along the River:** Ranger Rebecca Rising will present a program featuring the diversity of life along the Kings River from alpine country to the great central valley. Meet at the Cedar Grove amphitheater for this 1-hour program.

**Campfire Program: Fire in the Parks:** Join Student Volunteer Ranger Aubrey Eckert for a discussion about the natural history of fire and its use in controlled burning in Kings Canyon and Sequoia National Parks. Meet at the Cedar Grove amphitheater for this 1-hour program.
