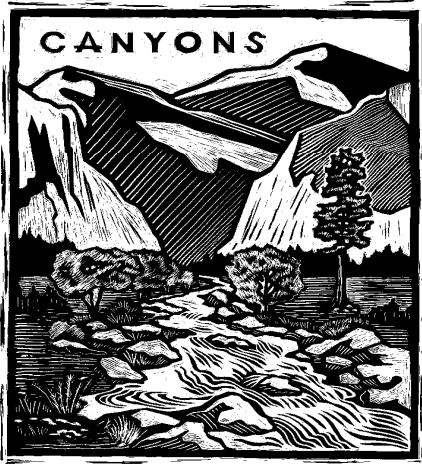

Program Descriptions
