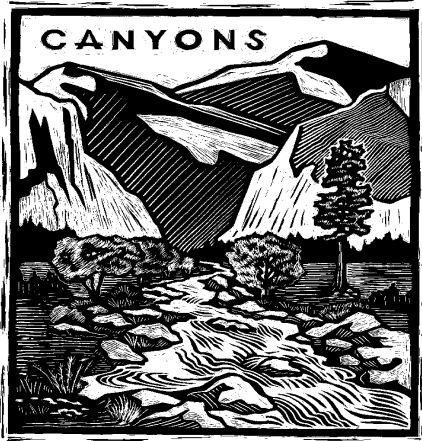

## Program Descriptions

**Bird Banding and Migration:** Meet International Volunteer Alan Monroy for to learn about international cooperation for bird conservation.
