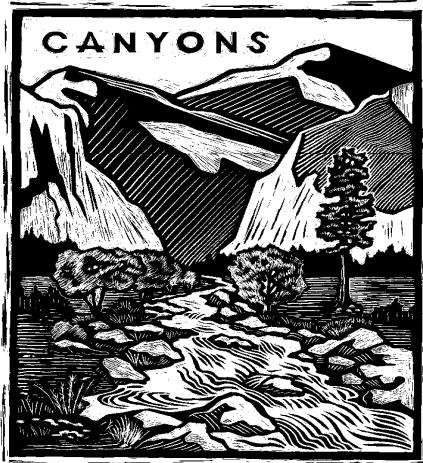

Program Descriptions
