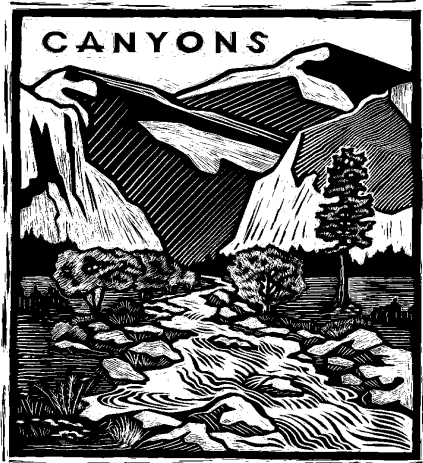

Program Descriptions

Zumwalt Meadow Meander: Explore the variety of environments around the largest meadow in Kings Canyon on a leisurely walk with a ranger.
