### Walks, Talks, & Hikes

#### **Patio Talk: *Wild About Bears!* Daily 10:30 AM**

#### ***Investigation Station*, Thursday – Saturday, 1:00 – 2:00 PM**

What can skulls, scat, and skin tell us about the lives of the animals that call these parks home? Drop in at the Foothills Visitor Center to discover the answers to these and other interesting questions and learn more about life in the park.

#### ***People, Places, and the Past: Discover Hospital Rock*, Daily 2:00 PM**

Step back in time and learn more about the people who called this area home. Meet at the Hospital Rock Picnic Area. 30 minutes.

#### ***A Walk in Paradise*, Saturday 7:00 PM**

Join a ranger for this twilight walk under a canopy of oak woodlands broken by ribbons of riparian forest and hear how the power, strength, and history of the Kaweah River has shaped the landscape and influenced humans throughout time. Meet at the Paradise Creek Trailhead in Buckeye Flat Campground across from site # 28 for this 1 hour walk.
