Program Descriptions

Critter Talk*	30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.
Lodgepole Campfire	1 hour. Meet at the Lodgepole Campground Amphitheater near Loop B. Topics vary.
Moro Vista Talk	30 minutes. Meet the ranger on top of Moro Rock. 1/3-mile climb up a stone staircase. Enjoy sweeping vistas and learn about your National Park!
Realm of Giants Walk	2 hours; 1 mile. Meet at the Giant Forest Museum. Deepen your understanding and appreciation of the world's largest trees.
Sherman Tree Talk*	20 minutes. Meet at the base of the General Sherman Tree. Learn about the largest tree on the planet and its secrets for survival.
Twilight Walk	1 ½ hours; ½ mile. Meet at Wolverton Parking Lot. When the sun sets, the day is only half over. Join a ranger in exploring who rises with the moon. Wear close-toed shoes. Bring bug spray and a flashlight.
Wuksachi Campfire*	1 hour. Meet at the Wuksachi Amphitheater. Topics vary.
