Program Descriptions

Astronomy on Moro Rock	1 ½ hours; ¾ mile. Join an experienced Sequoia Field Institute Naturalist at the base of Moro Rock. Hike to the top as the sun is setting, and enjoy topics such as the Park's ecosystems, constellations, moon facts, and night sky lore. Bring a flashlight and wear shoes with good traction.
Critter Talk*	30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.
Lantern Tour of the General Sherman Tree	1 ½ hours; 1 mile. Join a Sequoia Field Institute Naturalist for this evening adventure. Meet at the Upper Sherman Tree parking lot and bring a flashlight. (There is a fee for this program. Call 565-4251 for more information.)
Lodgepole Campfire	1 hour. Meet at the Lodgepole Campground Amphitheater near Loop B. Topics vary.
Moro Vista Talk	30 minutes. Meet the ranger on top of Moro Rock. 1/3-mile climb up a stone staircase. Enjoy sweeping vistas and learn about your National Park!
Realm of Giants Walk	2 hours; 1 mile. Meet at Giant Forest Museum. Deepen your understanding and appreciation of the world's largest trees.
