Giant Forest / Lodgepole Program Descriptions

Critter Talk*	30 minutes. Meet at the Lodgepole Visitor Center. Discover more about the animals that call Sequoia National Park home.
Forgotten Fridays: Silliman Meadow Hike	5 hours. Join a Sequoia Field Institute Naturalist for an exploratory day hike. Meet at Wuksachi Lodge Registration Building. This is a moderately strenuous hike. Bring lunch, water, close-toed shoes and appropriate clothing for the weather. (There is a fee for this program. Call 565-4251 for more information.)
Lantern Tour of the General Sherman Tree	1 ½ hours; 1 mile. Join a Sequoia Field Institute Naturalist for this evening adventure. Meet at the Upper Sherman Tree parking lot and bring a flashlight. (There is a fee for this program. Call 565-4251 for more information.)
Lodgepole Campfire*	1 hour. Meet at the Lodgepole Campground Amphitheater near Loop B. Topics vary.
Moro Vista Talk mile	30 minutes. Meet the ranger on top of Moro Rock. 1/3-mile climb up a stone staircase. Enjoy sweeping vistas and learn about your National Park!
Persieds Meteor Shower Astronomy*	1 hour. Meet in the Wuksachi Lodge Registration Building. Join a Sequoia Natural History Association Naturalist for this naked eye astronomy program. Bring a flashlight, jacket, and a blanket (optional).
Realm of Giants Walk	2 hours; 1 mile. Meet at the Giant Forest Museum. Deepen your understanding and appreciation of the world's largest trees.
Sherman Tree Talk*	20 minutes. Meet at the base of the General Sherman Tree. Learn about the largest tree on the planet and its secrets for survival.
Twilight Walk	1 ½ hours; ½ mile. Meet at Wolverton Parking Lot. When the sun sets, the day is only half over. Join a ranger in exploring
