



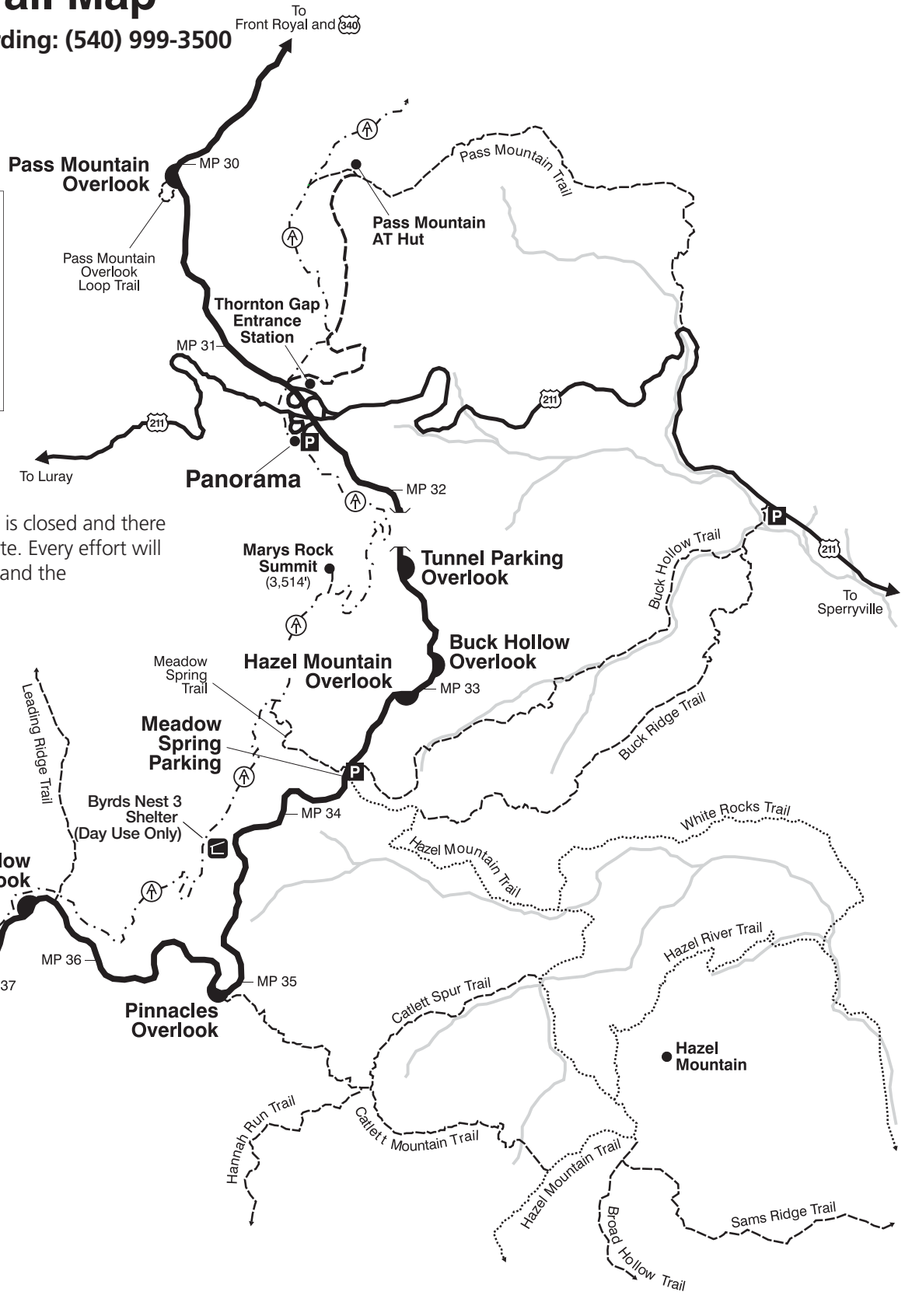
Panorama Area Road and Trail Map

You'll find these trail markers at all trailheads and intersections. The metal bands are stamped with directional and mileage information.



Note: The Panorama building is closed and there are no visitor services at this site. Every effort will be made to keep Marys Rock and the Appalachian Trails accessible.

Marys Rock from Panorama upper parking area - 3.7 miles round trip to an outstanding view, difficult.

Marys Rock from Meadow Spring Parking - 2.8 miles round trip to an outstanding view, moderately difficult.

Hazel Mountain - parking at Meadow Spring area. A network of trails through woods, streams, and cascades, as well as evidence of old homesites. Tailor to your ability and interest.

Note: Round trip hikes proceed to a destination and return by the same route. Circuit hikes begin and end at the same point without retracing steps.
