Claremont and Concord Railroad, Snowplow #60.

Snowplow, #60. Class: MWK. Built by Boston & Maine Railroad Shops before 1910. B&M number unknown. Has front truck with inboard bearings for better operation in the snow. Rear truck is a Fox-patent pressed-steel truck. Wood construction, wedge-shaped with steel spreader blades. Until 1954, the Claremont and Concord RR was a branch line of the B&M. When the branch line was sold, it became a short line. The snowplow, and other equipment, probably came with the real estate. By 1966 owned by Steamtown Foundation.
