Death Notice from Newspaper

PECK – In Hospital, at Murfreesboro, Tenn., March 17th, of chronic diarrhea, Howard, son of Benj. and Julia Peck, in his twentieth year.

He was born in Farmington, Trumbull co., O., Oct. 19, 1828. Aug. 3, 1862, he enlisted in the 101st Indiana Regiment. During the long and fatiguing marches of that portion of the army to which his regiment was attached he was never known to falter, but was always ready for duty, and by his cheerful disposition and manly deportment, won the confidence and esteem of his fellow-soldiers. But disease soon overtook and made him prisoner under the empire of death. The day before his death he said to his brother, who was with him in the hospital" We'll meet again in heaven." He was a kind son and an affectionate brother.
