



2010 Amateur Photo Contest

You're invited to participate in Voyageurs National Park Amateur Photo Contest. The purpose of the contest is to celebrate Voyageurs National Park's 35th anniversary and to encourage you to visit and enjoy the park. Each person may submit one entry in each of the following categories:

- a. Scenery
- b. Wildlife
- c. Recreation

The photos will be displayed at the Rainy Lake Visitor Center during August. Park visitors will vote for their favorites in each of the three categories through the end of September. Winners will be announced by October 31, 2010, and certificates, ribbons, and prizes (books, shirts, etc.) will be awarded. All entries will remain on display at the visitor center until December 31, 2010, and winning entries will be displayed on Voyageurs' web site (www.nps.gov/voya). Official rules are as follows:

1. Photographers must be non-professional; this is an amateur contest. All entries must be photographs taken in Voyageurs National Park.
2. Entries must include the following for each photograph:
 - a. One printed copy
 - b. One digital copy (on CD or other format)
 - c. One entry form
 - d. One photo release form (if people are included in photograph)
3. All photographs should be 5" x 7", 8" x 10", or 8" x 12". Both black and white and color photos are accepted. Photos may not be matted nor should there be any frame surrounding the photo. No captions or watermarks may be present on either the printed or digital copy.
4. All photographs must be taken at a minimum of 300 dpi.

6. Please cut out and attach the included entry form to the back of each photograph.
7. All entries must be received by July 31, 2010 to be eligible for voting.
8. Entries will not be returned. Photographs will be retained by Voyageurs National Park and may be used by the National Park Service for non-profit publications, web pages, and presentations.
