- Check-in begins at 1:20 pm at the Small Missile Range Gate on Highway 70 West between mile markers 174 and 175 (approximately 25 miles south of the visitor center).
- The tour leaves promptly at 2 pm. If you arrive after 2 pm, you will not be able to join the tour.
- Fees for the tour are \$3 per adult (16 & older) and \$1.50 per child (15 & under). Those with a senior or access pass are \$1.50 (cardholder only; annual pass does not apply). Fees will be collected at the start of the tour.

### *Mandatory Safety Requirements*

- You will caravan in your own car from the gate to the trailhead (17.5 miles one way). Have a full tank of gas before leaving home.
- No sandals or open-toed shoes. Closed-toed shoes are required.
- The tour is three hours long, two of which will be outside. Bring plenty of water (one gallon per person required), snacks, sunscreen, hats, and sunglasses for everyone in your group. Dress according to the weather.
- The hike to the lake shore is 3/4 of a mile over rough terrain and loose soils. This tour is not wheelchair accessible.
- Pets are welcome as long as they are friendly and remain on a leash.
