

WOLF TRAP SPECIAL USE PERMIT ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS

- A. Permit holders should contact the Chief Ranger or Lead Ranger once they arrive in the park to confirm permitted activity site location. Location will be determined on a first come first serve basis.
- B. Permit holders should not harass patrons or park visitors and attempting to stop vehicles is strictly prohibited. Permittee does not have exclusive use of the area including sidewalks and roadways. No interference with pedestrian traffic and no blocking of entrances or driveways is allowed. All areas must remain open to the general public at all times.
- C. Permittee is responsible for providing all necessary equipment/objects to conduct their activity. All equipment must be removed from the park immediately following the conclusion of the event and the participants must clean up the area prior to their departure. Items left in the park will be considered abandoned property and will not be the responsibility of the National Park Service.
- D. No fee may be collected, donation solicited or commercial activity conducted. No items may be sold or offered for sale except for books, newspapers, leaflets, pamphlets, buttons, and bumper-stickers which contain a message related to your demonstration or special event. No merchandise may be sold or offered for sale. A stand or structure used for the sale of permitted items may not exceed one table per site, which may be no larger than two and one half feet (30 inches) by eight feet or four feet by four feet. The dimensions of the sale site may not exceed six feet wide by 15 feet long by six feet high.
- E. The use of sound amplification equipment shall be limited so that it will not unreasonably disturb nonparticipating persons in, or in the vicinity of the area.
- F. The alteration, adaptation, damage or injuring, and/or removal of park resources or facilities is prohibited. No attachments (balloons, signs, etc.) may be made to trees, plantings, benches, etc.
- G. All vehicles must park in designated, available public spaces or as directed by park personnel. All equipment must be hand-carried/hand-carted to event site.
- H. No electricity is available. Permittee may use a generator for power, however refueling and the storage of fuels on parkland are prohibited. $\frac{3}{4}$ " plywood or similar material must be placed underneath generator to protect the surface.
- I. Soliciting personal information such as names, addresses, telephone numbers, zip codes, etc. or any other information which may be used for future solicitation, marketing purposes or memberships is strictly prohibited.
- J. A copy of this permit must be carried at all times while operating under the authority granted.
- K. The National Park Service reserves the right to immediately revoke this permit at any time should it reasonably appear that the permitted event presents a clear and present danger to the public safety, good order or public health, or if any conditions of this permit are violated.
