 - **Theater crew:** work at Children’s Theatre-in-the-Woods with box office operations, backstage operations, workshop and performer assistance, patron assistance; also assists with landscaping and painting projects. Full time: Tuesday – Saturday, 7am–3:30 pm
 - **Buildings crew:** work with the maintenance mechanic supervisor on a wide variety of facilities projects and general park maintenance. Full time: Monday – Friday, 7 am – 3:30 pm
