HISTORY

This collection was created by the Yellowstone National Park Archives to house materials, which document the Park, but have either unknown provenance or a size too small to warrant individual collections. Many of the items herein were found abandoned in houses, purchased from antiques dealers, or inherited by a family member who did not know the original creator. More information about the provenance of individual items is available upon request. This collection may be added to as future donations warrant.

DESCRIPTION

This collection was created by the Archives to house small groups of materials with related content: memorabilia and other materials gathered and created by those working in Yellowstone National Park. The collection includes letters, narratives, photographs, photograph albums, scrapbooks, and collectible materials such as vehicle licenses, stickers, brochures, and other small publications. Includes image (reproduction) of construction or framing crew for the Old Faithful Inn in 1902 or 1903. One worker is identified as Andrew Jackson Mason.

The collection is arranged chronologically. Items with the same provenance remain together. Folder labels include the individual accession numbers.
