HISTORY

Mary Wilson Orton was a longtime employee of the concessioner Hamilton Stores in Yellowstone National Park.

DESCRIPTION

Slides and film of Mary Orton's time working as a concessions employee for Hamilton Stores in Yellowstone National Park. The slides are a mix of personal images and purchased slides, including images by Haynes, Eric J. Sealch Co., and Pana-Vue. Commercial images include thermal features such as Mammoth Hot Springs and Old Faithful Geyser, wildlife, and landscapes such as the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone. Personal images include views of the Hamilton Stores, especially at Old Faithful, and winter in Yellowstone, including snowcoaches. There are also views of surrounding areas such the Tetons. Photographs include views of an earlier, ca. 1930s, Yellowstone National Park but include Colorado and Washington. There are also a couple of images of Orton in a group of fellow female Aircorps members at Lackland Field (now Lackland Air Force Base) at San Antonio, Texas.
