HISTORY

Kiyo, Yoshiko, and Mantaro Hide were Japanese-Americans who lived in Wapato, Washington. During World War II they were internees at the Heart Mountain WWII Japanese-American Confinement Site. In 1945, they were part of a group from Heart Mountain that visited Yellowstone National Park.

DESCRIPTION

This collection documents Japanese-American internees at Heart Mountain WWII Confinement Site (Heart Mountain, Wyoming) during World War II, who visited nearby Yellowstone National Park in 1945. The collection consists of four black and white photographs of the group watching Old Faithful geyser erupt, at Morning Glory Pool, on the beach of Yellowstone Lake, and in front of the Old Faithful Inn. The images are labeled in Japanese on the front and have translations and identifications in English on the verso. Group members included: Kiyo Hide, Yoshiko Hide, Mantaro Hide, Shinkichi Ihara, Sueki Furuta, Mrs. Suma, Mr. Tsukamoto, Kameju Kamemoto. Home locations are noted with the Hide family from Wapato, Washington, and other group members from the Yakima Valley, Washington. The image of the group in front of Morning Glory Pool is also contained within the George and Frank C. Hirahara Photograph Collection (SC 014.7, Box 1, Folder 292, picture 2) at the Washington State University Libraries Manuscripts, Archives, and Special Collections. Copyright for the image was previously transferred to WSU.
