HISTORY

Artificial collection created to hold photocopies, maps, indexes, historical reports, and other documents pertaining to the nearby cemetery. The cemetery has been managed or researched by several local fraternal organizations over time, including the Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie #669, Park County Genealogical Society, and the American Legion-Livingston and Gardiner chapters.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of maps, burial plot records, and genealogical records related to the Tinker Hill Cemetery, also known as the Gardiner Cemetery. Many of the headstones for the burials have been lost to weather and animals over time, much of this collection consists of varied efforts to identify and locate the names of those buried, and to research biographies and confirm veteran status to appropriately mark plots.
