HISTORY

This collection was created by the Yellowstone National Park Archives to house materials which document the Park, but have either unknown provenance or a size too small to warrant individual collections. Many of the items herein were purchased from antiques dealers or by visitors with no personal images to provide a broader context. More information about the provenance of individual items is available upon request. This collection may be added to as future donations warrant.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of photographs and related memorabilia produced and sold by F. Jay and Jack E. Haynes, under various company names while concessioners in Yellowstone National Park. The images are largely commercial views reproduced and sold as souvenirs in the Haynes Picture Shops throughout the park. There are also a few views of an on-demand type, which were sold only to the members of the group depicted, rather than more widely distributed. However, in this collection, information about the group is generally not known and the images were collected largely because of the photographer imprint on the verso. There is also memorabilia such as the widely circulated Haynes Family Christmas cards, company staff manuals, and the lecture notes to a slide program (though not the slides). Much larger and more complete collections of Haynes images may be found at the Montana Historical Society and the Archives and Special Collections of Montana State University. Additional Haynes images of both on-demand and commercially published types will be found throughout the collections of the Yellowstone National Park Archives as part of personal papers and official park records.

PROVENANCE
