HISTORY

Robin L. Smith was a student at The Ohio State University and a seasonal employee in Yellowstone National Park.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of the research material for A Case Study of the National Park Service Planning Process: Grant Village, Yellowstone National Park by Robin L. Smith. The work was undertaken as a thesis project and includes a number of oral history interviews; transcripts of the interviews are included. Although Smith was working in the park and the topic was suggested by park staff, the work itself was conducted as a personal student project. Note that the interviews do not include oral history releases. Several interviews are conducted with park staff.
