Photograph album of the Albin family who visited Yellowstone National Park with the Monida & Yellowstone State Co. in 1902. The album is exceptionally well labeled with a roster of members of the travel group and details of the stagecoach "Artemesia" and stagecoach driver, Mr. Cox. Images depict a typical trip around the park in this era, with views of the thermal features and landscapes as well as wildlife. This is a relatively early and well documented trip.
