### **HISTORY**

Theater performances in Gardiner, Montana, has largely been informal gatherings who come together for a season or two to produce plays and other theatrical performances. While some members have long-standing participation, others may only participate for a single event. The groups have not, as far as is known, formally organized as a nonprofit or educational institution. As a result, the name of the group has changed over time and has included The Occasional Gardiner Theatre Company (ca. 1996), Gardiner Community and Gardiner Community Center (circa 2004), and Yellowstone Players (ca. 2015). The groups have performed some traditional, published pieces, but has also performed several locally written plays, including The Family Reunion by Kelly Stermitz and Yellowstoners by Paul Condon.
