HISTORY

Percival Sargeant Goan visited Yellowstone National Park in 1914 or 1915, visiting on horseback and camping (or "sagebrushing"). Following service in World War I, he moved to Billings, Montana, and with his wife Annabel operated the Dude Rancher Lodge.

DESCRIPTION

The collection consists of photographs documenting a camping or "sagebrushing" trip to Yellowstone National Park in 1914 or 1915 by Percival Sargeant Goan. There are numerous images of the members of the camping party, life in camp, and visits to numerous thermal features. The collection is notable for its inclusion of members of the party as part of the typical tourist images of park features.
