HISTORY

Krapf worked as a Park Range in Yellowstone National Park, notably assigned to Tower Ranger Station. He also served as a wildland firefighter and interagency incident commander. After retirement, Krapf became an independent historian, writer, and Volunteer in Parks (VIP).
