

# **Key Points – User Capacity Process**

- Integrated into overall river planning process.
- Not a single number.
- Is an outcome of the planning process, not predetermined.
- Involves both science and value judgments.
- Identifies kinds and amounts of use appropriate.
- Applies monitoring to ensure that use does not adversely effect or degrade river values.
