



## CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS

### TITLE 36, CHAPTER I

Closure imposed

under the discretionary authority of the

Superintendent

In accordance with Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 1.5, authorized by Title 16, United States Code, Section 3, the following temporary closure is established for the proper management, protection, government, and public use of the portion of Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area under the jurisdiction of the National Park Service. This discretionary regulation is in addition to the other regulations published in Title 36, CFR, Chapter 1, Parts 2 through 7.

A 1.8-mile section of PA Route 611 through the park has been closed by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) for repair stemming from a rockfall incident along the highway. While the road is closed, Arrow Island, Point of Gap, and Resort Point Overlooks will be closed to visitors.

In addition to rockfall hazards, which will be mitigated during repairs, the entire stretch of road will be an active construction zone with heavy machinery and equipment operating in the corridor and at the repair site. For the safety of workers and visitors, the overlooks are closed until construction is complete or until it is deemed safe for vehicles and/or pedestrians.

#### **§1.5 Closure and Public Use Limits**

##### **1.5(a)(1) Arrow Island, Point of Gap, and Resort Point Overlooks are closed to visitors**

The park's three overlooks along Route 611 are closed to protect visitors and workers from safety hazards associated with active construction zones while repairs are made along the highway.
