



Research



Study question:

How does a GoNorth! adventure learning program affect students' motivation ?



89 % increased academic motivation

80 % increased motivation to learn about environmental issues

80 % increased motivation to seek out more information in content subject areas

* Participants and method: 2000+ schools, 150 pre and post implementation survey / 526 single post implementation survey; 228 respondents / 300 courses and phone interviews with 21 teachers.

Study question:


What are students longitudinal experiences with GoNorth! programs ?

Conclusion:

Students engage in sustained interactions with the context, experience and with each other.

Teachers practiced varied pedagogical strategies that afforded these student experiences.

85% of students “will not forget” their experiences with the GoNorth! adventure learning program.



* Participants and method: 1) 30 students (18 females, 12 males), 24 classroom observations over 2 years, 12 focus groups student interviews / 8 personal teacher interviews . Longitudinal panel study. 2) 24 teachers and 86 students, teacher / student surveys, student focus groups and personal teacher interviews . Constant comparative method.




WCCY: Student-driven circumpolar field research

WCCY is a students-science centered effort driven by the adventure learning programming at PolarHusky.com

During the annual adventure learning programs at PolarHusky.com our team collects field test and data for a number of research institutions. Since 2007 the National Science Foundation have funded a program - What Is Climate Change to You? - that has youth in remote Arctic communities join the scientific effort as our team travels through their communities. Team members work with youth and teachers to establish protocol, leave them with computers, cameras and all necessary field equipment. Youth then continue to collect logitudinal data from the community and surrounding area which they upload to an online environment for scientists to grab and use in their research. An important part of the research are environmental observations and stories supported by photography about local change. Student work is presented in a traveling exhibit developed in collaboration with United Nations Environmental Program: Many Strong Voices. Premiering at Denmark's National Museum, it has amongst other exhibited at the Olympics as well as the last two UN Climate Change Conferences.
