

## **Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve Commercial Use Authorization Activity-Specific Stipulations**

### **Attachment XX – 2015 Vehicle Tour Stipulations**

1. All passengers must be briefed on appropriate emergency procedures including exiting the vehicle, environmental conditions, and emergency communications.
2. If moose or other wildlife are on or near the road, the tour must stop and allow the animal to move off or away from the road on their own accord. At no time should the tour be close enough to change the behavior of any wildlife. Bears and unusual wildlife sightings should be reported to the NPS Visitor Information Station at 697-2627.
3. Vehicles are allowed only on established public roadways including main park road, lodge parking area, and Public Dock parking area. Areas NOT open to vehicle tours include the lodge employee housing, park utility areas (water plant, power plant), on the public dock, employee housing, and headquarters complex.
4. Vehicle engines shall be shut off while the vehicle is parked.
5. Passengers outside of the stopped vehicle must be in a safe location out of the lane of traffic to avoid a traffic hazard. The vehicle must also be stopped in a legal safe location.
6. Passengers should not approach, feed or harass wildlife.
7. Guides will demonstrate effective interpretive techniques and convey accurate information about Glacier Bay National Park and Preserve and its mission. Park interpretive staff may be available to evaluate accuracy of information
8. All activities shall be conducted in conformance with all Federal and State regulations and National Park Service Policies. This includes traffic regulations.
