

Denali National Park and Preserve Special Use Permit (SUP) Activity-Specific Stipulations

Attachment F – 2013 OVERNIGHT HIKING

1. Overnight Hiking is authorized in the 1980 park additions and preserve.
2. Group size is 12, inclusive of trip leaders/SUP holder staff.
3. Backpacking and basecamp hiking are permitted.
 - a. Backpacking is defined as hiking and camping in a different location each (most) night(s).
 - b. Basecamp hiking is defined as setting up a camp in one location, day hiking from the location, and returning to the camp for overnight stay.
4. Camps used for basecamp hiking must be relocated at least one-half mile, at least every three days.
5. Overnight camping in the Backside Lake area must take place at least one-half mile from, and out of sight of the lake.
