Attachment XX – 201~~32~~ Guided Sportfishing Stipulations

1. Freshwater sportfishing guide services are not authorized in Glacier Bay National Park South and East of Lituya Bay. "Sport fishing guide services," as defined under Alaska Statute (AS 16.40.299 - Definitions) "means assistance, for compensation or with the intent to receive compensation, to a sport fisherman to take or to attempt to take fish by accompanying or physically directing the sport fisherman in sport fishing activities during any part of a sport fishing trip;" Therefore the permittee, employees, or their representatives may not accompany or physically direct sport fisherman in freshwater fishing activities.

~~2.~~ Guided salt water sport fishing is authorized only if the Permittee posts on board each vessel, or provides each client, a copy of the State of Alaska "Guide to Eating Fish" (<http://www.epi.alaska.gov/eh/fish/FishConsumptionCalc.pdf>).

~~3.2.~~ The Permittee must submit a completed Sportfish Survey using the appropriate forms posted at http://www.nps.gov/akso/management/commercial_authorizations.cfm within five (5) days after the end of each month during which sportfishing activities took place. The permittee must report fishing effort for all areas of the park, including the portions of the Gulf of Alaska, Cross Sound, North Inian Pass, North Pass, Icy Passage and Excursion Inlet that are within the park boundary.
