## Special Use Permit Conditions

1. All requests for Special Park uses must be received at least 14 days prior to the proposed activity.
2. The \$50.00 application fee is non-refundable.
3. All activities must be free and open to the general public.
4. All activities will be confined to the "areas of use" (including parking), and "time period of use," approved on the permit.
5. Under NO circumstances will any government equipment, supplies or materials be used unless they are approved on the permit.
6. Smoking is not permitted in NPS buildings.
7. The permittee shall save, hold harmless, defend and indemnify the United States of America, its agents, and employees for losses, damages or judgements and expenses on the account of peril, bodily injury, death or property damage of any nature whatsoever, and by whomsoever made, arising out of the activities of the permit, the permittee's employees, subcontractors, or agents by this permit.
8. The permittee is responsible for any and all damages caused by the permittee or their patrons to the permitted park cultural and natural resources, and facilities (buildings, grounds, utilities, etc.) during the time of the permit.
9. The permittee and all participants authorized herein must comply with all conditions of the permit and any instructions of park representatives.
10. Good order and proper decorum shall be maintained by those persons conducting and/or participating in the permittee use activity.
11. The permittee's activities must not unduly interfere with the operation of the public use facilities, activities, or other programs within the park.
12. Permittee activities that include use of State or County roadways must be coordinated with the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation or local authorities.
13. The permittee or designated representative must be identified as the contact person for the Superintendent to confer with regarding conditions or the permit.
14. The National Park Service reserves the right to immediately rescind this permit at any time should the permittee fail to comply with any of the conditions or agreements stated in the permit, or if it should become necessary in the interest of public safety and general welfare.
15. Collection of soliciting funds of any type for any purpose without expressed permission contained in the special use permit is prohibited.
16. Selling or offering for sale any item or service without expressed permission contained in the special use permit is prohibited.
17. Sound amplification by any method is prohibited, unless approved as part of the special use permit.
18. The Superintendent will designate a representative to open, close and supervise the special use.
19. Additional fees will be charged to the permittee to cover unbudgeted costs, such as overtime, pre-event activities, after event cleanup, damages and repair, and supplies and materials.
20. All Federal, State and local laws and regulations will be enforced. Failure to comply will be grounds for revocation of the permit.
21. All promotional and information material related the execution of the permit must be approved in writing by the Superintendent prior to release.
22. The special use permit is not transferable.
