## 2009 - 2010 Hunting Season

### Amistad National Recreation Area Hunting Information

- Hunting at Amistad National Recreation Area is allowed only in five very specific Hunt Areas. Hunt Area maps are available at our Park Visitor Information Center on Highway 90, six miles west of Del Rio, and on the internet at our web site: [www.nps.gov/amis](http://www.nps.gov/amis)
- **No rifles or handguns are allowed.** These are archery-only hunting areas for hunting White-tailed Deer, Javelina, Turkey, Rabbit, exotic Mouflon and Aoudad Sheep, exotic Blackbuck, and Feral Hog. Shotguns with birdshot are allowed while hunting Dove, Quail, Duck, and Rabbit. Possession of buckshot and slugs is prohibited while hunting with a shotgun. Specific details on hunt areas, hunting seasons, bag limits, and regulations specific to the National Park Service are available at our Visitor Information Center.
- All hunters must have in their possession a valid Texas Hunting License, a National Park Service Annual Hunting Permit, a Drivers License or official photo identification card, and Hunter Safety Course Certification (if required).
- Hunters can obtain their \$20.00 National Park Service Annual Hunting Permit by going in person to our Park Visitor Information Center on Highway 90, six miles west of Del Rio. The Visitor Information Center is open seven days a week from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Bring your Texas Hunting License and a photo ID with you.
- Hunt Area #2 is subject to periodic closure when the National Park Service gun range is in use for official purposes. Signs will be posted at the entrance to Hunt Area #2 to advise hunters when the area will be closed.
