The Memorial Day ceremony is the largest event sponsored each year by the National Park Service at Andersonville National Historic Site. This year's ceremony will begin at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 24, 2015. A key feature of the ceremony is the laying of memorial wreaths in front of the rostrum. Your organization has either sponsored a memorial wreath in the past or expressed interest in doing so, and we would like to extend the offer again this year.

- Each wreath should be escorted by one or two members of the sponsoring organization during the ceremony.
- Only one wreath per organization.
- All flower stands must be metal; No wooden stands.
- All wreaths must be checked in between noon and 1:30 p.m. on the day of the ceremony.
