Some animals live with us as pets; others live in the wild. Explore the world of animals in the Try-it.




-Earth Our Home:

Learn how plants and animals live together as you become an eco-explorer.




-Listening to the Past:

About the Park:

Appomattox Court House National Historical Park is located on Highway 24 in Appomattox, VA.

Included within the historical village are a visitor center/museum, the McLean House, where Gen. Lee surrendered his army to Gen. Grant, and several other historical buildings.

The Park encompass over 1,700 acres of rolling hills, streams, woods and meadows; preserved to showcase the mid-1800's. A wide variety of wildlife lives within Park boundaries, including bear, deer, birds, fox, coyote and numerous other animals.

Park staff is available to work with Girl Scouts on badge programs as well as service projects. The Park has a list of suggested projects and welcomes your requests for projects to fill a specific requirement/need.


History Trail Program

Spend a day at the Park walking the History Trail answering questions and completing community service.

The Trail winds past Lee's Headquarters, Raine Cemetery, Lee's last attack wayside, North Caroling Monument and the Confederate Cemetery.

After finishing the trail spend time in the historic village completing a questionnaire to learn about Civil War events in Appomattox Court House in 1865.

After completing both the trail and village question sheets, girls earn the National Park Service Resource Stewardship patch.
