Make Your Reservations Now for the 15th Annual Ghosts of the Past at Arkansas Post National Memorial

Arkansas Post National Memorial's 15th Annual Ghosts of the Past program will be held on Saturday, October 24 at 5:30 p.m.

Your guide will lead you in a travel through time as you stroll down the luminary-lined trail around Park Lake and observe history come to life. Watch and listen as ghosts of the past depict life in Arkansas' earliest European settlement and the first capital of the Arkansas Territory.

Witness Spanish soldiers firing the cannon in Colbert's Raid and a wise woman tending to wounded soldiers during the Civil War. Hear traditional gospel songs as well as musings from John James Audubon on his visit to the Post.

If you have never experienced Arkansas Post at night – you will not want to miss this opportunity. Reservations are strongly recommended and can be made by calling (870) 548-2207. Admission is free and families are welcome. Tours begin at 5:30 p.m. and depart the Visitor Center every 15 minutes. Tours last an hour and a half. The last tour departs at 8:00 p.m.

Tours, trails, and buildings are wheel-chair accessible. Arkansas Post National Memorial is located on Arkansas Highway 169, approximately seven miles south of Gillett. It can be reached via US 165 and is about 20 miles south of DeWitt and 20 miles north of Dumas.
