Post Activity Instructions

As you just learned in the *Assateague Puppet Theater Presents: Story Time* video, animals wear different body coverings, colors, and features to help them survive. For this activity, clues will be read aloud and each player will mark the appropriate animal on the board. The game continues until one player marks four in a row, either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

Materials Needed:

- Four-in-a-Row Game Board (sheet with pictures of animals, four down and four across)
- A Marker (chips, crayon, pen, pencil)

Directions:

1. Print out a different Four-in-a-Row sheet for each player.
2. Print out the clues sheet.
3. Pass out a game board to each player.
4. Read clues aloud without reading the name of the animal to which it applies.
5. Each player will mark the appropriate animal on his or her board.
6. Continue steps (4) and (5) until one player marks four-in-a-row, either horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

Follow-Up Questions:

1. Ask: What is your favorite thing that animals wear and why?
2. Ask: What do we wear to help us when it is cold?
3. Ask: What does a fox have to help keep them warm when it is cold?
4. Ask: What does a snake do to keep it warm when it is cold?
