Applications need to be received in the Fee Management Office a *minimum* of 2 weeks in advance of the visit. Any missing documents will result in a delayed or unapproved waiver. Fee Waivers will not be given at the entrance stations. Fee waivers are not granted solely or partially on distance to park and/or economic justification.

Number of chaperones allowed: 20 college students: 1 chaperone; 12 high school students: 1 chaperone; 5 elementary students: 1 chaperone. **Fees will be charged for extra chaperones.**

Organizations that are considered service, civic, or fraternal (Scouts, Rotary, Elks, etc...) do not qualify for an Education Fee Waiver, unless they meet the above criteria.
