

## Artist Statement

Printmaker and artist Siri Beckman lives in Stonington, Maine. For many years her black and white wood engravings have captured the daily life of a small fishing community. In 1997 she received an artist's residency at Acadia National Park which led to future residencies in Badlands NP, Rocky Mountain NP and Hovenweep National Monument in 2004. These experiences proved to be transformative. While printmaking continues to be an important medium of expression, painting provides a way of testing ideas in a new landscape.

Siri is a member of Stonington Galleries, an association of Stonington artists. Her work can be seen at Turtle Gallery (Deer Isle, ME), Isalos Fine Art (Stonington, ME), Mulford Gallery (Rockland, ME) and William R. Talbot Fine Art (Santa Fe).
