



Alternative camping outside of Bandelier National Monument

**** Mileages are approximate; directions and mileages are given from the Bandelier Entrance Station**

West of Bandelier and Los Alamos (Jemez Springs and vicinity)

Information for below: USFS Jemez Ranger District of Santa Fe National Forest, 575-829-3535

American Springs: west on NM 4 7.2 miles; dirt road turns off on right side, USFS bulletin board at turnoff; primitive camping (no facilities, water, or fee) along dirt roads.

Dome Road: west on NM 4, 11.7 miles to turnoff. Follow Rd 289 until it enters Forest Service land; camping on dirt roads and pulloffs. Primitive (no facilities, water, or fee) Closed in winter.

Jemez Falls CG: west on NM 4, 24 miles. Left side of road, 2 miles on dirt. Tents, RVs, and trailers. No hookups or dump station. Drinking water, fishing, user fee. Closed in winter.

Redondo: west on NM 4, 26 miles. Right side of road, marked. Tents, RVs and trailers. No hookups. Drinking water, user fee. Closed in winter.

Vista Linda: west on NM 4, almost to Jemez Pueblo. Vault toilets. Open all year

San Antonio: west on NM 4, turn right onto SR 126 at La Cueva, Tents, RVs, trailers; water available, no hook-ups. User fee. Closed in winter. CLOSED 2010 FOR RENOVATIONS

Paliza past town of Ponderosa on 290. Vault toilets, user fee. Closed in winter.

Clear Creek - On SR 126 near Cuba. Vault toilets, drinking water, fishing; fee. Closed in winter.

Rio Las Vacas - On SR 126 near Cuba. Vault toilets, drinking water, fishing; fee. Closed in winter

Fenton Lake State Park: west on NM 4, turn right onto Rd 126 at La Cueva, 8 more miles. Some electric hook-ups; vault toilets. Fishing; ; OK for canoes/kayaks, no swimming. Some campsites year-round. Information: 575-829-3630

East of Bandelier and Los Alamos (Española area)

Nambe Falls (tribal): right on SR 4, to 502; north on 285/84 and quick turn right onto SR 503, to sign, then to Ranger Station: Tents, RVs, trailers; user fee (\$35 w/hookup, \$25 without)

Santa Cruz Lake (BLM): use directions to Nambe Falls, continue on 503 to lake turnoff. Fishing, no-wake boats (small lake) no swimming. User fee. 575-758-8851

Orilla Verde Recreation Area (BLM) - along Rio Grande, at Pilar. Water, shelters, restrooms, some hookups. Fee. 575-758-8851

Ohkay RV Park (tribal: Ohkay Owingeh Pueblo) in Española on Hwy 68; 505-753-7067. Fee

Roadrunner RV Park (tribal) - along Hwy 285/84 in Pojoaque at SR 502. 505-455-2626. Fee



Santa Fe Area

Hyde Memorial State Park on road to Santa Fe Ski Basin; dump station, some electric sites, main loop closed in winter; 505-983-7175

Black Canyon (USFS) - water, vault toilets, closed in winter; fee; near Hyde Memorial State Park on the road to the Santa Fe Ski Basin; 505-438-7840

Santa Fe KOA - on Old Las Vegas Highway, open March mid-November; 505-466-1419

Los Campos de Santa Fe RV Resort (private) - in town; 505-473-1949

Cochiti Lake (Army Corps of Engineers) follow signs from I-25; electric hook-ups, dump station, year-round; fishing, boating, swimming; Tetilla Peak summer only. 505-465-0307

Bernalillo Area (15 miles N of Albuquerque)

Coronado Campground (commercial) - on 550 in Coronado State Monument, but not part of the Monument. Hookups, shelters, showers; fee. Tent section closed in winter; 505-980-8256

Bernalillo KOA - near junction of 550 and I-25, open all year, 505-867-5227
