Submit as appropriate:

- **Visual Artists (photographers, sculptors, painters, etc.)**- Four CD with six different images in jpg or tif format. More than six images or pictures exceeding 3 MB in size result in disqualification. Video photographers send three copies of the same disc
- **Writers** - Four CD containing six pages of written examples
- **Musicians/Composers** - Four copies of the same music CD
- **Performing Artists** – Four copies of the same CD
- **Multidiscipline Artists** - Send appropriate sample combinations based on the above. Visual artists, except video photographers, writers, and multi-discipline artists may submit all materials on the same CD.
