Superintendent Ramos:

There is currently no ORV access to any portion of the Preserve West of Turner River road. Since the INTENT of the 1974 Preserve legislation was to allow ORV access to ALL of the preserve, any area restricted to ORV's can only be restricted for justifiable scientific reasons.

We hereby request a clear timeline as to When and Why all particular areas were closed to ORV's west of Turner River road. We have not been presented to date any evidence that any of the closures were done by a proper process.

I recall while unloading my buggy at Concho Billy years ago someone ask me did I know that Buggies were no longer allowed West of Turner River road. I consider myself one of the more active people, so if there had been any proper process going on I would have been aware of it.

The NPS needs to fully realize that we will not stop until all of the existing improper, illegal restrictions in the Preserve are lifted or otherwise justification be brought forward by the NPS that the restrictions should continue today.
