Big Cypress Prescribed Fire Notification

Big Cypress National Preserve has one of the largest fire programs within the National Park Service. The peak of the fire activity within the Preserve typically occurs from November through May. Prescribed and wild fires may often close facilities within the Preserve.

Date/Time: January 23 through 25, 2009

Over the next few days the fire crews within the Preserve will be conducting burn operations late afternoon along east side of Birdon and aerial ignition along the north boundary 4 miles east of HWY 29 as well as around the Headquarters facility.

No facility closures are anticipated.
