

Over 200 species of birds use Buffalo National River for some part of the year and many live here year round. Nearly 100 species will build nests, lay eggs, and raise their young here during summer. Others stop to feed and rest during spring and fall migrations between breeding grounds in the northern U.S. and Canada, and wintering areas in Central and South America.

The following is a partial list of birds that can be found at Buffalo National River. The birds on this list are more likely to be heard than seen. The challenge of identifying birds by only their song or call can be a rewarding experience for bird watchers of today and future generations.
