Highland House Museum is a classic example of a turn of the century summer hotel. A visit to the museum affords a fascinating insight into the everyday life of the past, from the time of the Pamet Native Americans to the early days of the century, when electricity and paved roads were unknown in Truro. In 1996 the Highland Lighthouse, also known as Cape Cod Light was moved back from the eroding cliff to save it from falling into the ocean. The visitor can view a 10-minute video and climb the lighthouse tower to take in the incredible view from the top. Take a short walk from the lighthouse to the observation deck, where you can enjoy the view over the beach or a spectacular sunset.
