CAPE COD NATIONAL SEASHORE SAFETY POLICY

- The park, including all employees and cooperators, will fully comply with safety requirements.

- Safety is everyone's responsibility. Every employee will help identify and control hazards. Every employee will help eliminate unsafe behaviors.
- When any employee identifies a workplace hazard, work will proceed only after the safety concerns are addressed and controlled.
- An effective safety program requires individual and team effort and a strong commitment to continuous improvement. Management, Employees, and AFGE Local 3789 will work together on all aspects of safety including safety awareness, accident prevention, reporting and correction of hazards, and investigation of accidents in order to improve our program.
