The Cape Cod Model – a new approach to establishing National Park units.

The mosaic of landownership within the seashore boundary requires the six towns of the Outer Cape to be partners with the federal government in preserving the Cape Cod Character through town zoning bylaws.

Enabling Legislation

- Established the park boundary
- Set the parameters for acquiring private, state and local land including by condemnation
- Set conditions of the suspension of condemnation for residential and commercial properties
- Set requirements for towns to have "valid zoning bylaws approved by the Secretary"
- Defined Improved property
- Required the Secretary to set minimum zoning standards.
