

The Pathways Program provides a clear path to internships and careers in the Federal Government for students and recent graduates. This Program consists of three excepted-service programs: the Internship Program, the Recent Graduate Program, and the Presidential Management Fellows (PMF) Program.

- The Internship Program targets students enrolled in a wide variety of educational institutions. It offers them opportunities to work with the NPS and explore careers while completing their education. To be eligible, you must be a current student in an accredited high school, college (including 4-year colleges/universities, community colleges, and junior colleges); professional, technical, vocational, or trade school; advanced degree program; or other qualifying educational institution pursuing a qualifying degree or certificate.
- The Recent Graduates Program targets recent graduates of trade and vocational schools, community colleges, universities, and other qualifying educational institutions. To be eligible for this program, you must be a recent graduate who has completed, within the previous two years, a qualifying associates, bachelors, masters, professional, doctorate, vocational or technical degree or certificate from a qualifying educational institution. Veterans unable to apply within two years of receiving their degree, due to military service obligation, have as much as six years after degree completion to apply
- PMF Program is the Federal government's premier leadership development program for advance degree candidates. Individuals who have completed, within the past two years, a qualifying advanced degree (e.g., masters or professional degree) are eligible.
